The two day event held in San Francisco this week brought high-profile climate advocates, business leaders and policy makers together from around the world. There will be various events taking place across the week to celebrate the progress made towards Goal 13, Climate Action, and re-emphasise that further changes need to take place if we're to curb climate change. Without dealing with climate, none of the Goals will be reached.

These events show how Climate Action contributes to all of the Goals. Global experts to work in groups to accelerate tangible, technology solutions for the Oceans. GCAS produced sharable content in the form of a suite of short films as well as initial investor decks.
